Facility Planning

Nick Nemecheck and Andy Fahrmeier reviewed and discussed the Program Budget which included strategic cost options comparisons. Superintendent Rumford also went over the handouts provided by Dustin Avey – PiperJaffray Representative, showing mill levy history and mill levy impact of bond issues at \$24.8 million and \$25.5 million. At 7:08 p.m., the board, Superintendent Rumford, and parties present, left to tour sites of the facility planning and came back to the board meeting room at 8:05 p.m. The scope and budget amount of the project was further discussed. Consensus of the board was to stay around the \$25 million amount for the bond project.
