President Leann Wiechman called the meeting to order.

Facility Planning

Superintendent Rumford informed the board that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss where the facility plans are at in reference to the bond issue and where the plans are going. Nick Nemecheck, GMCN Architect and Andy Fahrmeier, Hutton Construction Manager, presented new drawings of the middle school concept which has gained the popular vote among staff and committees and is the plan that will work the best for school functionality. Pros and cons of both type of gyms – top-load vs dome – was discussed in length and consensus was to go with the top-load type gym. Also discussed were the tennis courts and wrestling room.

Mark Davis made a motion to adjourn. Chris Price seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
